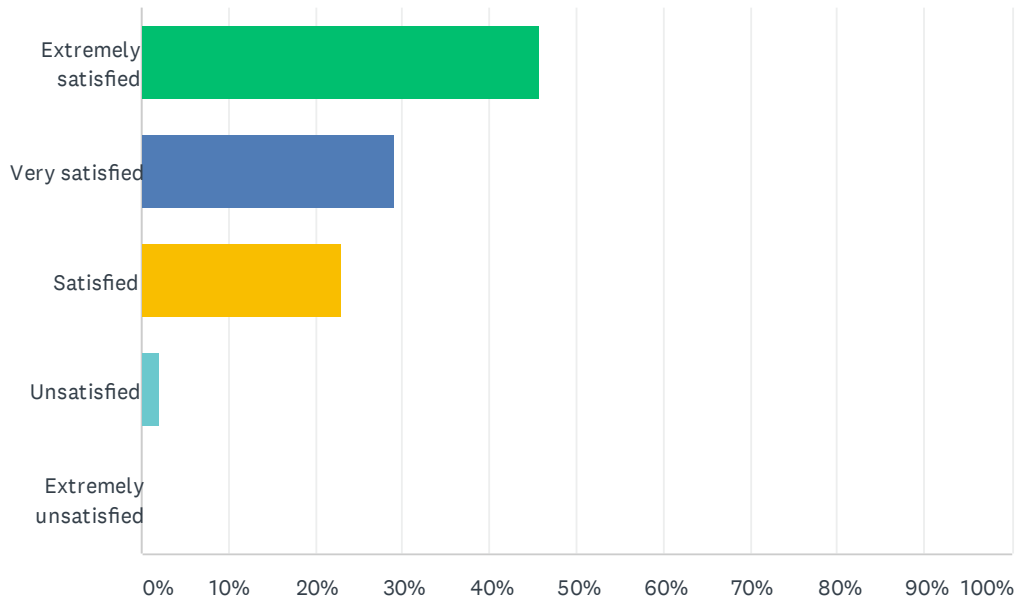


# Q1 How satisfied are you with your Cybersecurity Externship overall?

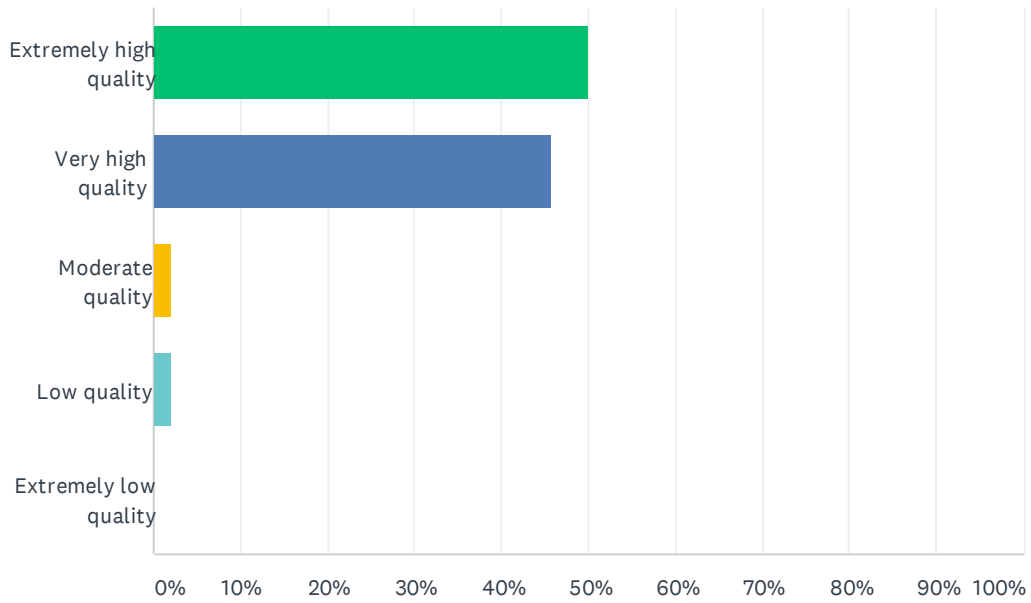

## Q2 Please rate the overall quality of the instructors.

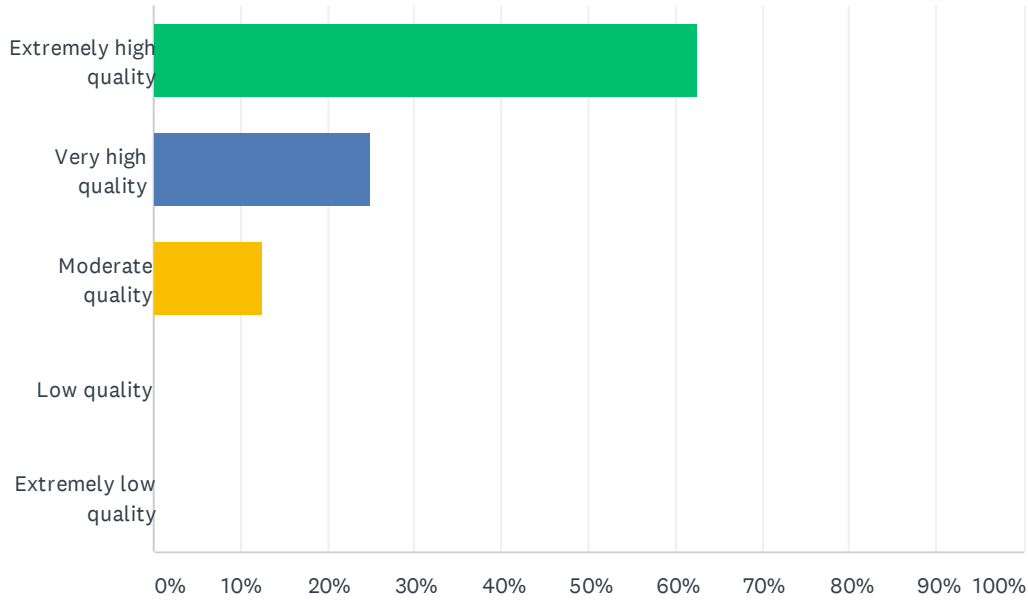

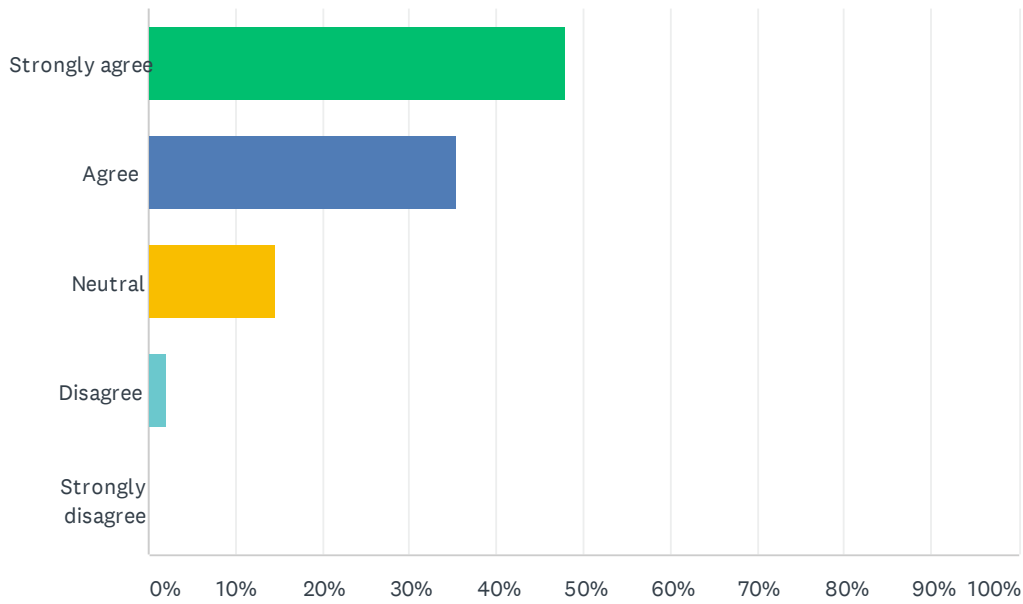

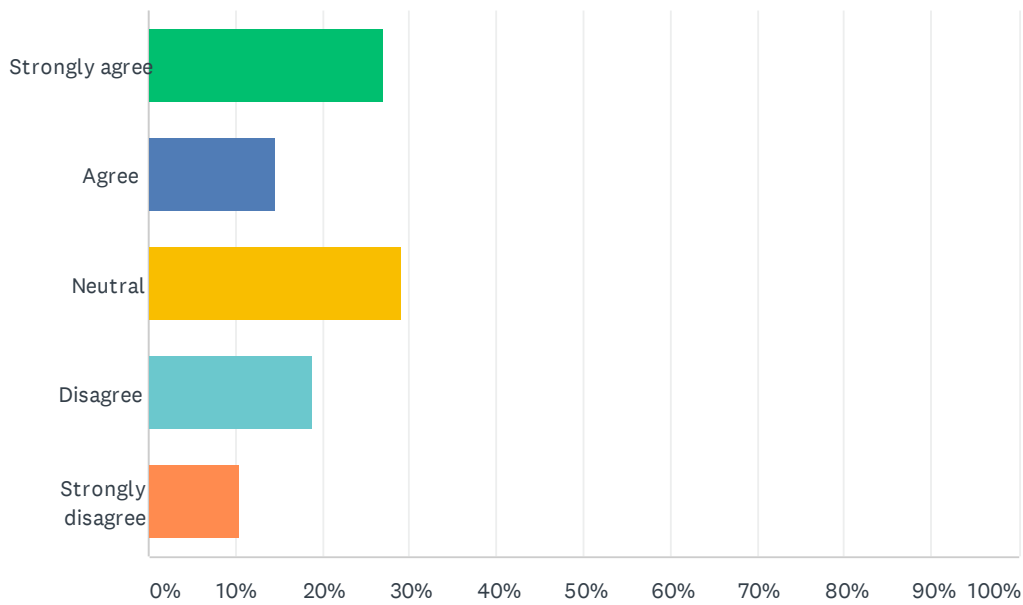

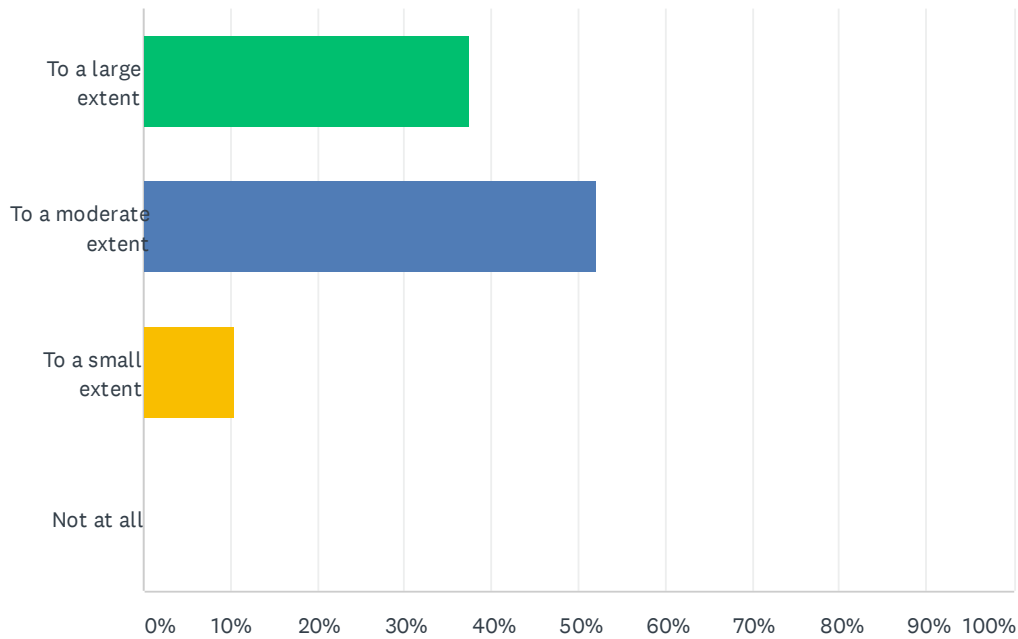

### Q7 To what extent has this externship experience helped you network with potential future employers?

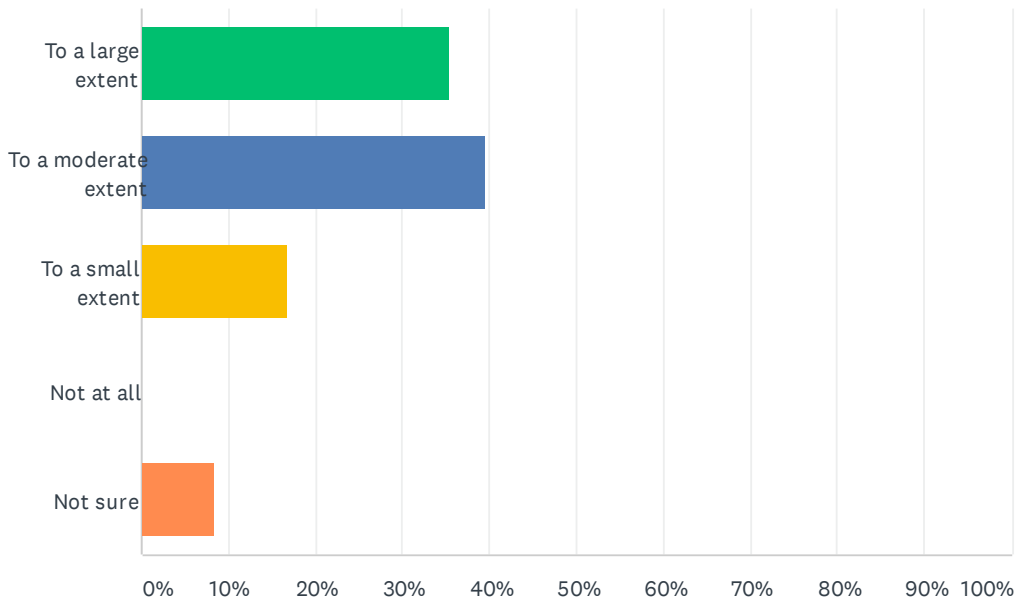

### Q8 To what extent will the technical skills that you learned during this virtual externship will help you in your future career?

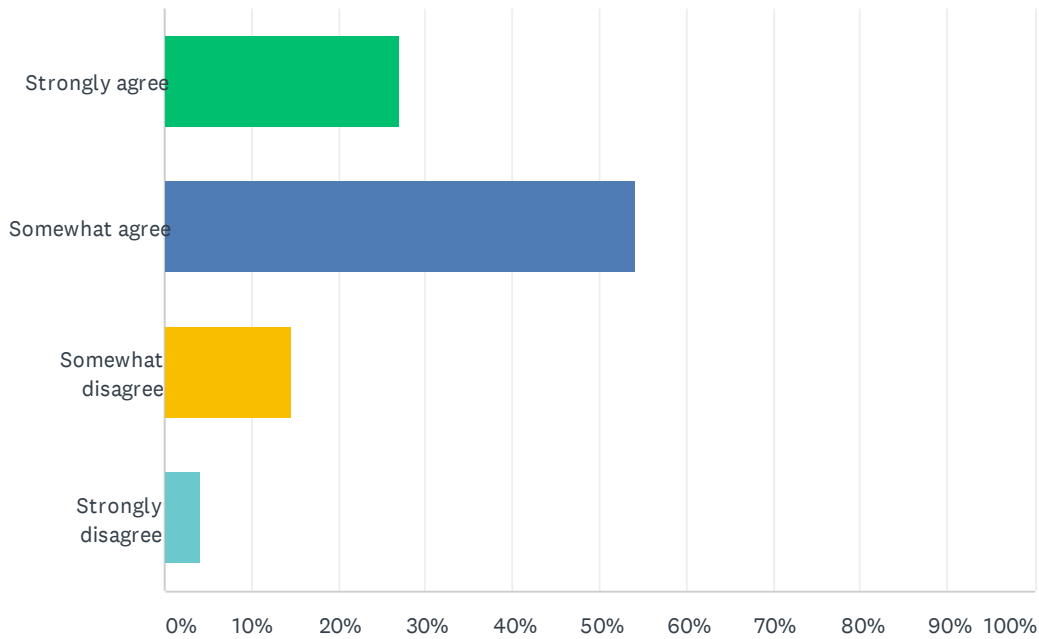

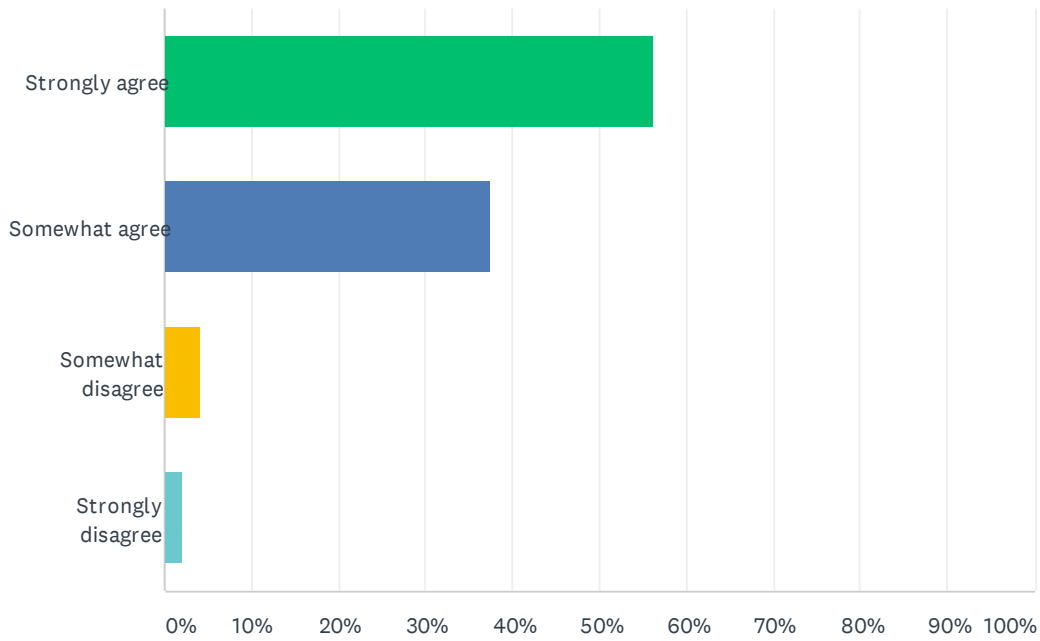

### Q14 Participating in this externship made me more interested in Cybersecurity.

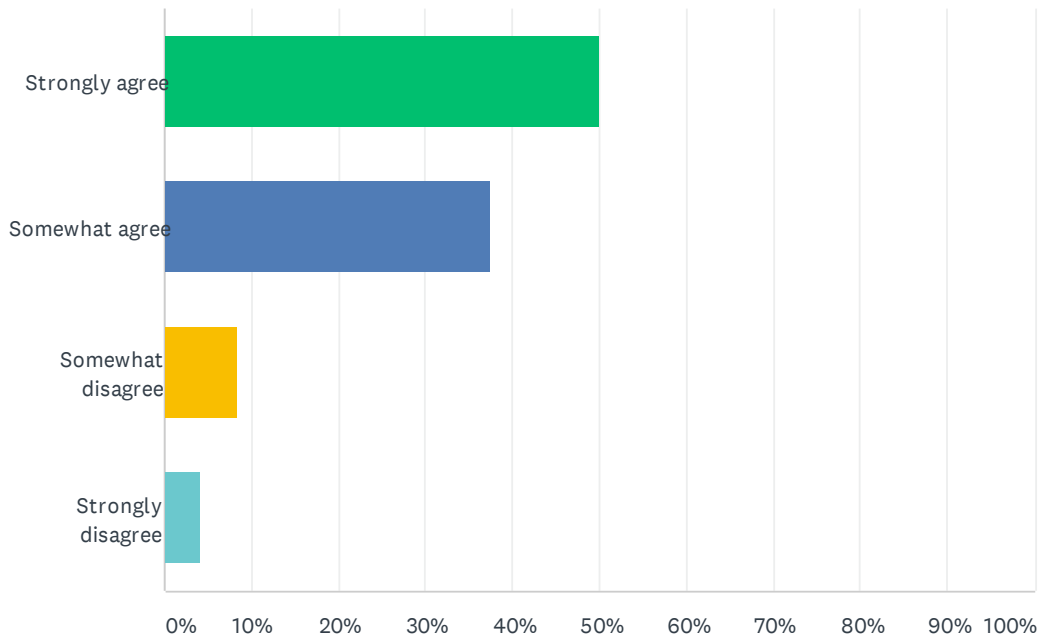

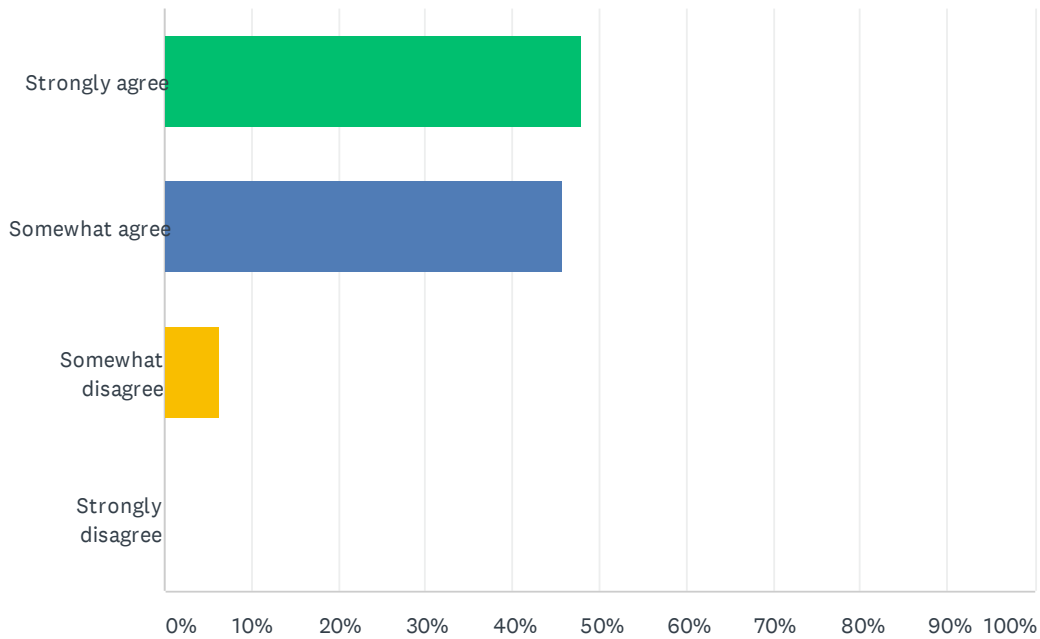
